#### ALZHEIMER'S REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

Over 1,000 advocates are scheduled to attend the Alzheimer's Advocacy Forum in Washington, DC on

March 23-25, 2015. Our hope is to turn Capitol Hill purple as we advocate for an additional \$300 million for Alzheimer's research at the National Institutes of Health, and support the passage of the Health Outcomes, Planning, and Education (HOPE) for Alzheimer's Act.

### LEGISLATIVE REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

Nearly half of the 250 attendees were first-time participants at the Legislative Training Conference in Arlington, VA. Representatives Barbara Comstock (R-VA), Don Beyer(D-VA), John Delaney (D-MD) Gerry Connolly (D-VA) and Derek Kilmer (D-WA), each having a 100% voting record in favor of NARFE issues, were among the numerous speakers providing tips on how to be more effective on Capitol Hill. Also, a panel of congressional staffers from the offices of Representatives Chris Van Hollen (D-MD), David N. Ciciline (D-MI) and Senator Gary C. Peters (D-MI), were on hand to answer questions. We attended breakout sessions on grass-roots advocacy and policy issues, and learned more about NARFE's legislative agenda for the 114<sup>th</sup> Congress, all in preparation for Capitol Hill Day on March 17. Maryland has a total of 305,909 Active and Retired Federal and Postal Employees. However, only 14,854 are members of the Federation of NARFE Chapters. We must find ways to recruit more members if we want our 32 chapters to survive. Meanwhile, Senator Barbara Mikulski's announcement that she will not seek re-election in Congress has set off a whirlwind of candidates vying to run for her Senate seat in 2016. She said she would prefer to spend the two years remaining in her term campaigning for Maryland residents rather than campaigning for herself. The two issues I would like to see her succeed in are; that funding at the National Institutes of Health for Alzheimer's research be increased to \$2 billion annually, and that we finally bring the Alzheimer's disease Research Semipostal stamp to fruition.
