<< President's Message >> Elinor Abrell • 301-831-8753

Chapter 409 is pleased to welcome as the speaker for the December meeting Jake Wynn from the National Museum of Civil War Medicine in Frederick. Jake has given us presentations twice in the past three years; many members will recall that he is indeed an engaging speaker with a wealth of knowledge and interesting sidelights of that era. You won't want to miss this program!

The deadline to keep Federal agencies funded is coming up again, very soon. The current Continuing Resolution expired on November 21. No substantive progress has been made on the twelve regular appropriations bills, as the attention of Congress has been focused on other matters. The House has passed ten of the bills while the Senate has passed none. This raises concerns about the possibility of another stalemate like the one that caused the month-long partial Government shutdown at the beginning of this year. Issues that have bogged down the budget process remain unresolved, with the impeachment inquiry now complicating matters. Included in these unresolved matters are several bills important to the Federal community, including the amount of pay raise for Federal employees and language to stop any further breakup of OPM enabling a merger with GSA. Such disagreements raise the prospect of need for another Continuing Resolution, likely sometime in early December. This seems to have become a common practice in recent years, usually with a final agreement reached shortly before year's end.

Did you know that IRS has a new 1040 form designed specifically for Americans age 65 and up? This new Form 1040-SR is just two pages long and uses a large print with minimal shading around boxes. The rationale is that older taxpavers will find this form brighter and easier to read. A standard deductions chart is also on the form, which will allow the taxpayer to immediately figure out what, if any, refund they are due (previously seniors had to look this up).

Do you have a friend or former work colleague who is now a retired Fed? Recruit that person to become a NARFE member. Until December 31, the recruiter of a newly joined member is eligible to receive a nice reward of \$20.

There has still been no action by the Senate with respect to a pay increase for Federal workers in 2020. As stated in the last THE KEY NOTES, the House of Representatives has passed legislation to give Federal workers a 3.1% raise for 2020. The President has indicated his support for a 2.6% raise. Members of NARFE should contact their senators to support the 3.1% raise in the House bill.



<< NARFE/MD: Scam Alert! >>

This is notification from Dr. Gary Roundtree, Sr., Maryland Federation President, that his email has been hacked again and that someone is sending fraudulent email in his name, asking for money/donations, as well as phishing for information. If you get an email that says it is from Dr. Gary Roundtree Sr., pay close attention. Look at the underlying email address; it may be in the clear and not be Dr. Roundtree's email address, or if it isn't in the clear, hover your mouse over his name to see what the real underlying email address is. Dr. Gary's email address has roundtree in it. Please do not open but delete any email that you can tell is not from Dr. Roundtree. Please do not respond but delete any email that is asking for donations or money in Dr. Roundtree's name. These scam emails often ask for the recipient to purchase gift cards. Do not fall prey to this scam and send money or purchase anything. It has happened in the past. As examples: Two emails with identical content (shown below) showing that they were from Dr. Roundtree, but the email addresses were in the clear:

presidentboard450@gmail.com & vicepresident450@gmail.com

Hello. (name omitted), How are you doing today? Can you do me a favor please??? Thanks. Dr. Gary Roundtree, Sr.

The subject was URGENT. <u>Please don't respond to this type of message content either</u>. Whomever you would respond to is just phishing for information.

Thanks for paying close attention to these types of scam emails
