# LEGISLATIVE REPORT

The House Budget Committee Chair Paul Ryan, R-WI, and Senate Budget Committee Chair Patty Murray, D-WA, reached an agreement, which authorizes funding for federal agencies through fall of 2015 avoiding a government shutdown for the next two years. Democrats and Republicans in the House came together to pass H.J. Res. 59, the Bipartisan Budget Act, by a vote of 332 to 94. This is the first bipartisan budget agreement to come out of a divided Congress since 1986, and in doing so, sequestration is offset for fiscal years 2014 and 2015. The agreement now heads to the Senate for a vote. The agreement, if passed in the Senate, has the President's support and would be signed into law ahead of the January 15 deadline set by the current continuing resolution. Beginning in 2014, new hires in federal service will pay 1.3 percent more of their salary towards retirement, creating a third tier of contribution percentage for Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS) employees, which depends on the date of hire. Pre-2013 FERS-covered employees pay 0.8 percent; 2013 hires are paying 3.1 percent; and 2014 and beyond hires will pay 4.4 percent for their FERS pensions. The 10-year savings for this provision is \$6 billion. The only other change in federal benefits is the creation of a long-sought "self plus one" coverage option within the Federal Employees Health Benefits Program (FEHBP). NARFE participated in a press conference on the grounds of the U.S. Capitol and a rally in front of the White House opposing the change to the proposed Chained CPI. That change to the CPI calculation was not included in this agreement.

#### MEMBERSHIP REPORT

This month's membership report continues our chapter decline in membership. We had 1 reinstatement, 10 dropped for non-renewal, and 3 transferred out of the chapter.

includes signature and date. Please ensure that part D has been completed with the signature and address of two witnesses. Click on the above link to print out a copy of this form. If you do not use the Internet, feel free to contact me and I'll arrange for you to receive paper copies of this form. My phone number is on the last page of this newsletter.

Please note: This form must be free from any erasures, mark-out/through, white out, or strike over. If the form contains any alterations, it is not valid.

An insured retiree must send the Designation of Beneficiary form to the Office of Personnel Management, Retirement Operations Center, P.O. Box 45, Boyers, PA 16017-0045.


