LEGISLATIVE REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

The NARFE Hotline is 1-877-217-8234. This number provides the latest information and advice for advocacy. The number is available 24/7.

The Hotline often urges phone calls to members of Congress. Calls to members' Capitol Hill offices can be made toll-free by calling the Capitol switchboard at 866-220-0044. Callers can ask for a representative or

senator by name, or provide a ZIP code to learn whom to ask for. It is important that everyone take a more active role in contacting their elected officials as threats to our hard earned benefits are proposed. Our job is to increase awareness of the contributions of federal employees to our nation, refute inaccurate perceptions about federal pay and benefits, and voice our opposition to proposals to cut the benefits of active and retired federal employees.

Such as (H.R. 1780), introduced by Rep. Dave Camp, R-Mich., on April 26, would "provide that the only health plans that the federal government may make available to the president, vice president, members of Congress and federal employees are those created under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act or offered through a health insurance exchange." The Camp bill would dismantle the Federal Employees Health Benefits Program by forcing employees into the state exchanges created under the ACA. The legislation does not mention retirees at this time. NARFE is strongly opposed to this and any effort to denigrate the services provided under the FEHBP.

Sequester forced the Office of Personal Management (OPM) to reduce its call center hours by nearly three hours each weekday, to save money. Sequester has thrown a wrench into OPM's recent successful effort to speed up its processing of new retirees' pensions and whittle down its backlog of unresolved cases. OPM has cut its backlog of unprocessed claims by 40 percent, from 61,108 in January 2012 to 36,603 in March 2013.

The Resolution submitted by Chapter 409, to support legislation that would establish a fundraising stamp called "semipostal" for Alzheimer's disease, was adopted by the Maryland Federation NARFE Convention in Ocean City, MD. The Resolution will be referred to NARFE National. On April 11, 2013, Representative Edward Markey (D-MA) introduced H.R. 1508, that provides for the issuance of an Alzheimer's Disease Research Semipostal Stamp. Please contact Representatives John Delaney at 202-225-2721 and Chris Van Hollen at 202-225-5341 and ask them to cosponsor H.R. 1508. We need cosponsors to move this legislation out of committee and bring it to a vote.
