We are also reviewing which fundraising events can be successfully accomplished, with help from our members. We will share our findings at a later date.

March will be a very busy month for me starting with my attendance at the NARFE's Legislative Training Conference in Arlington, VA. Members from across the nation will gather to take part in workshops, welcome keynote speakers and prepare for Hill Day on the 17th. Then off to Washington, DC to attend my 15th Alzheimer's Advocacy Forum to prepare for Hill Day on March 25th. My schedule will allow me to attend our luncheon on March 20th to hear our guest speaker Mr. Ted Meyerson, who will talk about all kinds of technology available to help seniors stay in their homes, not just using a computer. Since I'm a slow learner of new technology, it will be a must for me to attend. Hope to see everyone there and please remember to bring a friend or prospective NARFE member.

There are 32 NARFE Chapters in the Maryland Federation. On February 3, Chapter Presidents voted to approve the MD Federation FY2015 – FY2016 Budget at our board meeting in Bowie. Mr. Dan McGrath, Maryland State Federation President announced that The Maryland State Federation's Bi-Annual Convention will be held at the Carousel Oceanfront Hotel, 11700 Coastal Highway, Ocean City, MD on April 26 – 28, 2015, for the purpose of electing officers for the next two years and to discuss resolutions

germane to the Federation. In addition to the Convention Registration Fee of \$45 and Banquet Fee of \$45, a special rate of \$63.00 per night was negotiated with three days prior to and after the convention for your convenience. The convention is open to all members and I hope you will consider taking advantage of a mini vacation during that time to join us in Ocean City.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

NARFE's Legislative Department is keeping a close eye on three bills.

1st - Congresswoman Donna Edwards (D-MD) has reintroduced her legislation to repeal the increased retirement contributions that newly hired federal employees began paying in 2013, and were then raised for newly hired employees starting in 2014. The legislation, The Federal Employees' Pension Fairness Act (HR 785), is retroactive in the sense that it applies to employees already paying the higher contribution rate but they will not receive the money they've already contributed back.

2nd - HR 313, the Wounded Warriors Federal Leave Act of 2015. Introduced by Stephen Lynch (D-MA), the legislation would provide 104 hours of sick leave for newly hired federal employees who are disabled veterans (at least 30%) so that they can continue their treatment or rehabilitation.

3rd - Congresswoman Carolyn Maloney (D-NY) reintroduced her legislation to give federal employees up to six weeks paid time off after the birth or adoption of a child. The legislation is HR 532 and was added to the NARFE Legislative Program during our National Convention in Orlando, FL.
