### LEGISLATIVE REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

I'd like to call your attention to an article on page 24, in the February 2017 narfe magazine which explains the potential threats to your earned pay and benefits in the 115<sup>th</sup> Congressional Session. NARFE members from across the nation will gather in Alexandria, VA to attend the NARFE 2017 Legislative Training Conference, March 12-15, 2017, culminating with visits to Capitol Hill on March 15. The challenge this year is to play big-time defense against serious efforts by this administration to cut federal pay, their retirement system, the employee-retirees' share of health premiums and their Medicare Part B premiums. It's time for you to take a stand! On the local level, please consider attending the MD Federation 43rd Biennial Convention in Ocean City, MD on April 30 – May 2, 2017. We will select officers for the next two years, discuss resolutions germane to the Federation, and attend workshops on legislative and membership issues. Senior Federal and Maryland State officials have been invited for the opportunity to exchange views on issues related to protection and enhancement of current and retired Federal employees' earned benefits. There will be a reception on Sunday two luncheons with excellent evening. speakers, and a banquet with a live band on Monday. ### ALZHEIMER'S REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

Congress approved a short term Continuing Resolution (CR) in December to fund the government through April 2017, keeping funds at the 2016 budget level. The CR increases the threat of losing the \$350 to \$400 million of additional funding for Alzheimer's research approved by the Appropriations Committee in the FY 2017 budget. Advocates have worked long and hard to achieve milestones in funding for Alzheimer's research, and helped pass legislation to provide support for families and care for the millions of American living with However, these services are Alzheimer's. being implemented through Medicare under the Affordable Care Act (ACA). Sadly, it is unclear whether these services will continue if the ACA is repealed. On another note, I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for supporting the Alzheimer's bake table at our monthly luncheons. Because of your generosity Chapter 409 was able to contribute \$825 to NARFE's Alzheimer's research in 2016, in support of our national goal. I recently attended Advocates Day in Annapolis and I will be attending my 17<sup>th</sup> Alzheimer's Advocacy Forum in Washington, DC in March. 
