#### **CO-PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

As you may know the Federal Legislators are considering changing the Cost Price Index (CPI), used to determine our annual COLA, from the CPI-W formula to the so-called Chained-CPI formula to compute our Cost Of Living Adjustment (COLA) each year. This would cause the CPI value to be smaller than the CPI-W value. This would apply to both federal employees retirement annuities and Social Security payments. I encourage you to contact your Congressional Representative and our Senators to protest this proposed change. Also, there is some concern about changes to our Federal Employees Health Benefit Plan (FEHBP) related to the new Affordable Care Act (ACA). Although ACA was not set up to replace plans such as the FEHBP, there is a bill in Congress (HR 1780) that would dismantle our health care program and place FEHBP active employees (not retirees) into the ACA health exchanges. However the passing of such a bill would result in higher health care costs for retirees. Please let your congressional representative know that the dismantling of our FEHBP is not supported by NARFE members.

Our guest speaker for October will be Julia J. Pedroso, RN, MA, Research Manager, Bayview Psychiatry, Johns Hopkins University. She oversees the Clinical Trials conducted on Alzheimer's research at Johns Hopkins.
