ACTING PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Nearly 1,000 delegates and guests attended NARFE's 33rd Biennial National Convention in Orlando, FL. Attendance was lower than in previous conventions perhaps due to the number of deaths reported by the 10 regions at the Memorial Service. NARFE has lost a total of 24,535 members since our last convention two years ago, making recruitment and retention a major topic at this year's convention. Delegates voted (about 80% in favor) to adopt the resolution to reduce the National Resident Officers from four to two, and authorized the National Executive Board (NEB) to continue developing the model of Future of NARFE (FON). The general FON resolution, authorizing the NEB to continue planning for changes with the FON report as the foundation, received 86% of the votes in favor of adoption.

Effective November 1, our National officers will be President, Richard Thissen, and Secretary/Treasurer, Jon Dowie. This will save us about \$500,000 over a two-vear term to be used to increase marketing/recruiting efforts. A resolution requiring the NEB to establish a Strategic Planning Committee by February 2015 was also approved. That committee will be responsible for keeping the Future of NARFE moving forward. Evelyn Kirby ran unopposed and continues to be Region II Vice-President.

Our October 24th Candidates' Forum will include candidates for Congressional District 6: John Delaney and Dan Bongino and candidates for Congressional District 8 Dave Wallace and Bill Parson, representing Chris Van Hollen. We are pleased to have Mr. Cliff Cumber, Editorial Page Editor for the Frederick News Post as our moderator. Hope to see everyone there and please remember to bring a friend.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

Delegates approved the NARFE Legislative Program for the 114th Congress (2015-2016) to be published in the NARFE magazine. Chapter 409 submitted a resolution to the National Convention to include legislation for a semi-postal stamp to support medical research relating to Alzheimer's disease, but was rejected by the Legislative Committee as "Outside of NARFE'S Core Mission." Although withheld for debate, the resolution was defeated and will not be included in the legislative program.

With the fiscal year ending September 30, and without the enactment of any of the 12 regular appropriations bills, congressional leaders are intent on passing an eight-week stopgap funding bill and recessing again to allow members to return home to campaign. A postelection or 'lame-duck' session will likely begin November 12.

ALZHEIMER'S REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

Expecting to reach our goal of \$11M by September, delegates voted with their applause to set a new goal of \$12 million for Alzheimer's research by convention time 2016. The NARFE-Alzheimer's National Committee under the leadership of Jane Rogers, Chairman, approved \$439,931 to fund an additional three research projects, bringing our total to 63 since NARFE's Alzheimer's program began in 1985. A courtesy resolution was introduced and approved to include a request for additional funding for Alzheimer's research when speaking to our legislators.

CONGRESSMAN CHRIS VAN HOLLEN'S 2014 FEHB FORUMS

Congressman Chris Van Hollen will host his 12^{th} annual FEHB forums in cooperation with NARFE on Monday morning, November 17^{th} from 9 a.m. – 11 a.m. (Panel: 9:30-10:30 a.m.) at the Holiday Park Senior Center, 3950 Ferrara Drive, Wheaton, MD 20906; and, Wednesday evening, November 19^{th} from 7 p.m. – 9 p.m. (Panel: 7:30-8:30 p.m.) at the Executive Office Building, 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, MD 20850.This is the chance to talk with representatives from health insurance companies about their FEHB plans and learn from experts from OPM, NARFE, and Consumer Checkbook.
