LEGISLATIVE REPORT **Kathy Siggins**

There are three critical issues on Congress' agenda this fall. Funding the government for the new fiscal year which begins October 1, extending highway spending authority which expires on October 29, and raising the debt ceiling by mid-November or early December to avoid default. Congress is likely to pass a short-term Continuing Resolution (CR) that will fund the government through mid-to-late November, or just before Thanksgiving. At that time, another CR or longer-term spending plan will have to be passed. Meanwhile, talks of a government shutdown continues to haunt the halls of congress.

Q: How do I update the beneficiaries for my Federal Employees Group Life Insurance (FEGLI)?

A: You should download and complete SF 2823 - FEGLI Designation of Beneficiary ensuring that the information in part A and B is complete and totals equal 100%, part C information is complete and includes signature and date. Please ensure that part D has been completed with the signature and address of two witnesses. Click on the above link to print out a copy of this form. If you do not use the Internet, feel free to contact me and I'll arrange for you to receive paper copies of this form. My phone number is 301-938-2000.

Please note: This form must be free from any erasures, mark-out/through, white out, or strike over. If the form contains any alterations, it is not valid.

An insured retiree must send the Designation of Beneficiary form to the Office of Personnel Management, Retirement Operations Center, P.O. Box 45, Boyers, PA 16017-0045.

Also I would like to remind you that OPM Retirement Services introduced a way for annuitants and survivors to use their Services Online (SOL) account to receive their annual notice and IRS Form 1099R. Since then, thousands have signed up to receive these mailings using SOL.

OPM has stated that it will continue to keep SOL secure and easy for users to access now and in the future. One objective of SOL is to help reduce OPM's carbon footprint by reducing the number of mailings it

sends out. To sign up, visit www.ServicesOnline.opm.gov.

If you don't remember your password, directions for obtaining a new one are given. SOL passwords expire after 15 months of non-use.
