Later in the year we will cover topics such as genealogy, learning about common scams targeting the elderly, and learning more about our local ancestor, Francis Scott Key.

Kathy Siggins and I will be the interim Co-presidents for this year, sharing the presidential duties, since we were unable to find a volunteer to be president of our chapter. Scott Darby will be our new Newsletter Editor and Kathy Kusel will take over the job of Luncheon Reservations/Coordinator. We wish to thank them both for stepping up and taking on their new duties. Without Kathy's commitment we would have NO luncheons. She also loves fried chicken so expect to see more on our menus. It's very important for you to step up and help. So please feel free to attend our monthly Board meetings that are held at 9:30 a.m. on the Tuesday morning of the week of our luncheon at the same location (the American Legion). LEGISLATIVE REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

Invitations were extended to the offices Congressmen John Delaney, 6th District, Chris Van Hollen, 8th District, and Senators Barbara Mikulski and Benjamin Cardin, to attend our legislative luncheon and give us an overview of how things are going or NOT going in Washington. After a five-week August recess, Congress will be back in session with votes scheduled on the day of our luncheon so our hope is to have their staff available for comments.

The federal budget cuts relating to active and retired federal employees continue to be of great concern to the federal community. The three-year federal pay freeze, which continues, along with the increase in retirement contributions for those hired on or after January 1, 2013, have cost federal employees \$114 billion thus far. Furloughs are adding up to an additional 20% cut in pay for those who are forced to take two days off per pay period. The more frequently cited threat would incorporate the Chained CPI into a sweeping package or "grand bargain." Discussions of such a grand bargain are part of the agenda as Republican senators continue meeting with topranking White House officials. If adopted, seniors who generally spend more on healthcare will suffer the brunt of the proposed Chained CPI with a loss of .3%

each year in COLAs.

Republicans and Democrats on the House Oversight and Government Reform Committee expressed the desire at their last hearing to finalize a bipartisan bill to reform the Postal Service.

If we do nothing and say nothing, Congress will think it's OK and continue the attacks on federal workers and annuitants in the name of deficit reduction. We can't let this happen.
