I am extremely grateful for their support, and for their commitment to help make NARFE a stronger organization for all of us, as we review the proposed changes, and vote on the Future of NARFE. I would also like to take this opportunity to extend a huge thank you to all the wonderful ladies who help out with the door prize tickets and our Alzheimer's bake In addition to our national goal to fund table. Alzheimer's research, monies raised by the sale of these tickets give us the opportunity to donate directly to local organizations that supports the senior population in our community. We are truly grateful for your participation in providing goodies for our bake table, and for purchasing lots of tickets. If you have any suggestions on how we can improve our fundraising efforts, please feel free to share with any member of our board. Now for our program this month: we are pleased to welcome Ms. Jan Gardner and Mr. Blaine Young, Frederick County's candidates for County Executive. Although the county doesn't have influence on NARFE issues, they do, however, have a large impact on all of us as citizens and taxpayers of Frederick County. Our moderator for this event will be Cliff Cumber, Editorial Page Editor for the Frederick News Post. You don't want to miss this one, so put it on your calendar, and please bring a friend.

### LEGISLATIVE REPORT Kathy Siggins (301-829-2462)

Following a five-week summer recess, Congress will return to session on September 8th. The NARFE Bill Tracker in your August magazine gives you the full list of legislation that NARFE is monitoring. Here are just a few:

**Postal Reform** - the Postal Service has been unable to unilaterally switch to 5-day delivery due to language in the Appropriations bills that require the Postal Service to maintain service at the 1983 level which includes 6day delivery.

**The Fair Act, H.R. 4306/S.2397** - introduced by Rep. Gerry Connolly, D-VA and Sen. Brian Schatz, D-HI, would provide a 3.3 percent pay raise to federal employees in 2015. However, the House and Senate Appropriations bills remain silent on this issue. If Congress does not take action on the pay increase, the President's proposed 1 percent increase will likely go into effect in January 2015.

**The Smart Savings Act, H.R. 4193/S.2117** - The House passed the bipartisan legislation, which would shift the default fund of the TSP from the G Fund to the L Fund. Currently, new federal civilian employees have their TSP investments automatically placed in the G Fund, unless and until they elect otherwise. The Senate bill has been reported out of committee and is awaiting floor action.

**Pension Contributions Hikes - H.R. 5338** introduced by Rep. Donna Edwards, D-MD, and cosponsored by Rep. Gerry Connolly, D-VA, - would repeal two separate increases on the amount federal workers must pay toward their pensions. A 2012 law to extend unemployment insurance forced employees hired in 2013 and those with less than five years of federal experience to pay an additional 2.3 percent for a total of 3.1 percent of each paycheck toward their defined benefit. The 2013 budget agreement required all employees hired after 2013 and with less than five years of federal experience to pay a total of 4.4 percent of their salaries toward their Federal Employees Retirement Systems accounts.

Mr. Harry Johns, President and CEO of the Alzheimer's Association, will address our members at the National Convention to give us an overview as to how NARFE's investment (\$10,939,669.08 as of June 30<sup>th</sup>) in Alzheimer's research has been spent. Upcoming event: The Walk to End Alzheimer's will be held at the Maryland School for the Deaf on October 19, 2014. Registration is 1:00 p.m. and the Walk at 2:00 p.m. This is the largest fundraising event that the Alzheimer's Association does nationally to raise awareness and funds for Alzheimer's care, support and research. Please join me and my family as we participate in our 21<sup>st</sup> walk, in memory of my late husband, and in honor of the 97,000 individuals living with Alzheimer's in Maryland.
