

#### **Writing to Your Legislator**

It is very important that we let our elected officials know our views. The wider our voices are heard, the more impact Chapter 409 will have on important legislation. When you write, remember these key hints:

- Keep to one subject, give facts, and tell the essentials.
- Give your personal views. Tell how the issue affects you and your family.
- Use your own words, stick to the point.
- Don't be afraid to send a handwritten letter.
- Use proper salutations:
  - o **MD US Senators**: The Honorable full name, Dear Senator Last Name
  - o **MD Representatives**: The Honorable full name, Dear Mr./Mrs./Ms. Last Name
  - o **MD Legislator**: Dear Senator or Delegate Last Name
- Members who live outside Maryland's 6<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> Congressional Districts can go to <u>https://mgaleg.maryland.gov/mgawebsite/Members/District</u> or call the Maryland Archives Help desk at 410-260-6487 for the names of your legislators.

#### **Our History**

• Chapter 409 was established on December 7, 1967, in order to join with other Federal employees in protecting hard-earned benefits. We met first in members' homes, then, as our membership grew, meetings were moved to a local fire house and then to local service clubs. Currently, meetings are held at the Golden Corral Buffet & Grill, 5621 Spectrum Drive, Frederick, MD 21703. Meetings take place on the second Tuesday of the month. Buffet starts at 11:00 AM, program starts at 12:30 PM. If Frederick County schools are closed for weather, the luncheon meeting is canceled. If County schools are delayed but open at meeting time, the luncheon meeting will be held as scheduled.

#### **Our Members**

- Donated \$25,400 to local charities that benefit senior citizens.
- Donated over \$20,775 for research on a cure for Alzheimer's disease and another \$19,915 for treatment of those afflicted with the disease in the local area.
- Continuing support of the Maryland Federation of Chapters, NARFE. Two members have served as Federation President, and many have served on Federation committees.
- Volunteer in city, county, and state organizations working to enhance the quality of life for all senior citizens.
- Initiated the national drive to have the Postal Service issue an "Alzheimer's semi-postal stamp" to raise awareness about the disease and to provide research funds to help discover a cure.
